DJG Picture Competition

Are you a Yemeni photographer and/or an artist? Then submit your picture to the German-Yemeni Society's picture competition!

Background: The German-Yemeni Society's (DJG) annual magazine, the *Jemen-Report*, is turning fifty! In order to honor the occasion, we would like to ask Yemeni photographers and artists to submit one picture (photograph, painting, drawing, cartoon etc.) focusing on German-Yemeni relations. How you interpret this topic is up to you (we are also open to critical perspectives), there are only two conditions: 1) Your picture is oriented vertically in order to fit the magazine's format. 2.) You may neither make use of current or former flags of the two countries (or their parts before unity) nor use these flags' colors.

We therefore invite you to submit one vertical (!) picture to our competition on 'German-Yemeni relations'.

- 1.) The winner will receive a prize of 400 EUR and the winning picture will be displayed on the cover of next year's issue (to be published in March 2019).
- 2.) The runner-up will receive a prize of 300 EUR and the selected picture will be displayed on the back cover of next year's issue.
- 3.) The third to fifth place will each receive a prize of 100 EUR and the pictures will be displayed on the cover of one of the three sections within the magazine.

All five winning artists will be featured with a short profile and contact details. Please provide both as well as a profile picture of yourself (not obligatory) along with your entry.

We will also try to display all other submitted pictures in the issue if there is sufficient space.

How do you submit your picture? Email it as jpg-file with high resolution (at least 300 dpi) to Marie-Christine Heinze (heinze@djg-ev.de) by 31 December 2018. Don't forget to also submit a short profile of yourself (5-6 sentences), your contact details and a profile picture (the latter is not obligatory) along with your entry. By submitting your picture to the competition, you hand over all rights to it to the German-Yemeni Society.

The winners will be selected by a three-member jury composed of

- Marie-Christine Heinze (editor of the *Jemen-Report*)
- Dr. Joachim Gierlichs (member of the German-Yemeni Society's advisory board on arts & culture)
- Prof. i.R. Dr. Horst Kopp (former editor of the *Jemen-Report*)
